- Present Continuous Tense: affirmative form;
- We use the present continuous to describe things that are in progress now / at the moment.
- What are you wearing today?
- I <u>am</u> wear<u>ing</u> a red shirt, jeans and black boots.

I/you/he/she/it/we/they +
"to be (am/is/are)" + verb-ing

#### Present Continuous Tense: affirmative form;

Look at what happens when we add – ing to these verbs:

come → coming give → giving

run → running
sit → sitting
swim → swimming
travel → travelling

You aren't going.

He/She/It isn't

We aren't

You aren't shouting.

They aren't

I/you/he/she/it/we/they + am/is/are +not + verb-ing
